Sketches in the sand

The Rolls-Royce 'R'-type engine which broke every world speed record—land, sea and air—was originally sketched out by Henry Royce with his walking stick in the sand of West Wittering beach near his home in Sussex. It happened on a beautiful autumn day in 1928. Royce had been on a stroll with three of his colleagues, discussing Britain's need to retain air supremacy when, tired of walking, he said, 'Let's find a sheltered spot and have a talk.' From that chat and the simple sketch was born one of the most successful racing engines of all time—and the precursor of the Spitfire's Merlin engine, which helped prevent Hitler from overrunning England—much of the free world today, owes its freedom to this engine, and the simple sketch in the sand...

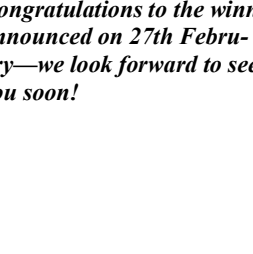
